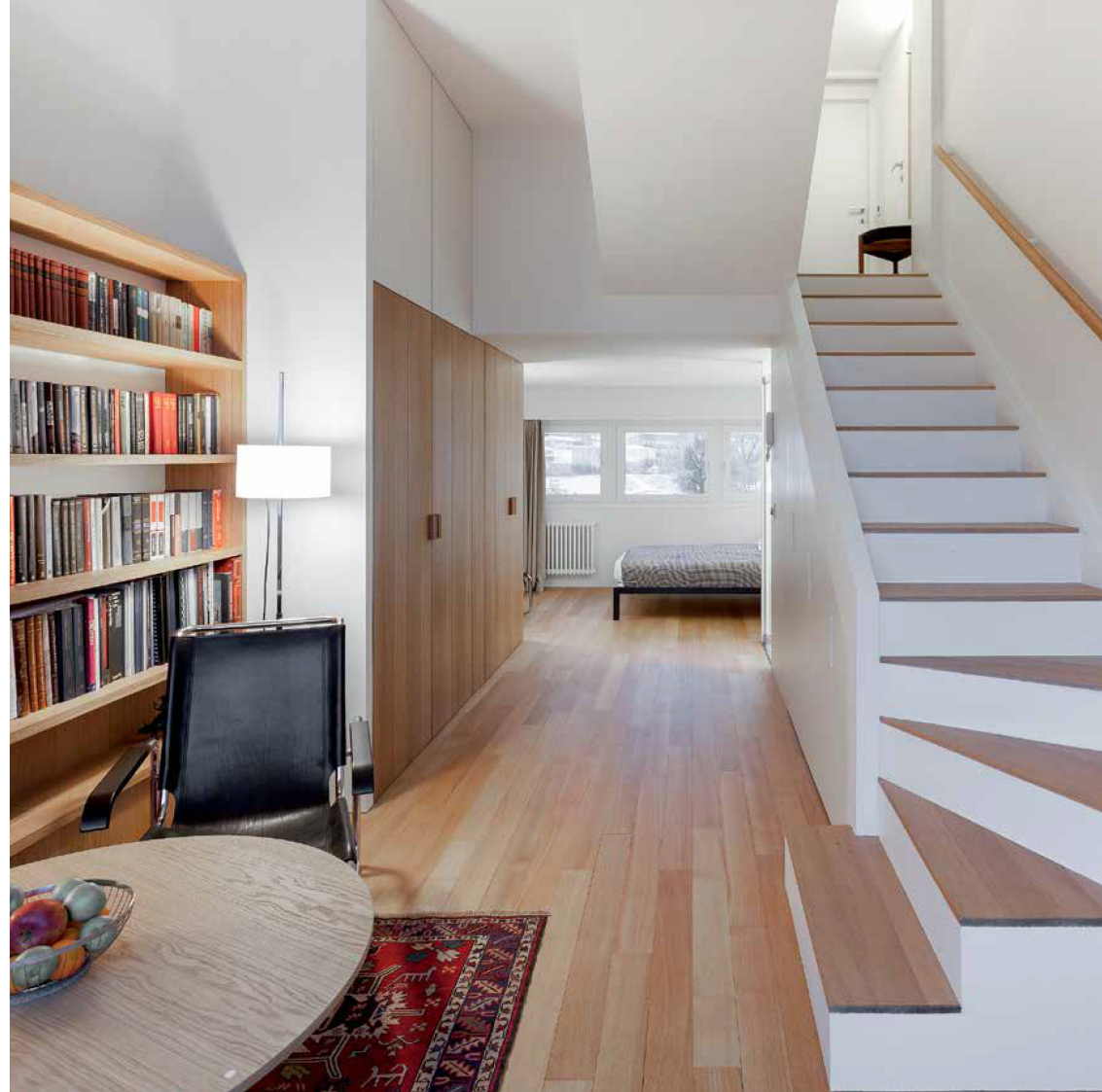

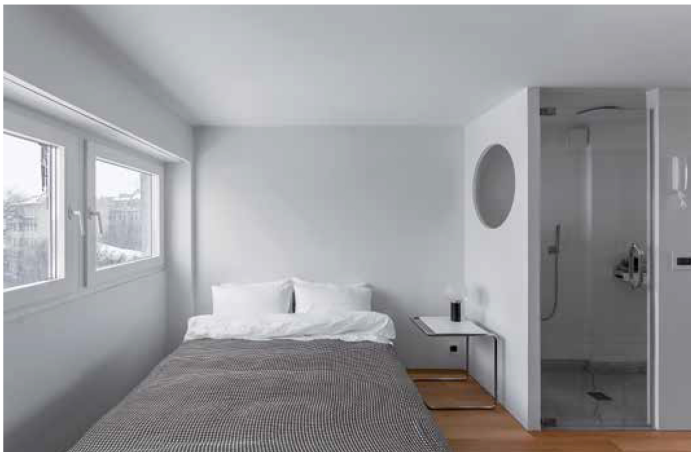

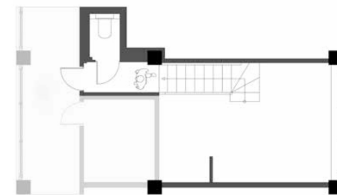


The client was a single man who wanted to renovate his 33 sqm apartment so that it would be a contemporary place with all the facilities to meet a modern urban lifestyle. Several blocks help to organize the interior structure, housing a kitchen, laundry, bookshelf, pull-out wardrobe and a storage space. The bookshelf occupied the entire wall between the kitchen block and the windows. In order to keep the window free, a recess was made in the structure of the bookshelf, which became a place for hanging chairs for guests. Next to the kitchen block is a wardrobe with a washing machine, cleaning and laundry accessories. A curtain embedded in this block separates the bedroom and bathroom from the living area, making them more private and cozy.

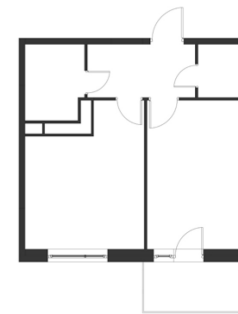

A furniture system was developed to make the most of the limited space. The wooden sleeping box with storage system offers a certain privacy that separates the bedroom from the kitchen and living area. From the inside of the sleeping cabin you have a good view of the whole apartment and the windows, making it a very comfortable place. Under the sleeping box there are three sliding shelves for large appliances. The furniture system consists of a dresser, drawer and wardrobe. The shelves on the upper side of the wardrobe are connected to the sleeping box and form a mini-storage for the inside of the box. The living and dining areas are very flexible, by moving the sofa and extending the dining table the apartment easily becomes a comfortable space suitable to accommodate about ten guests.
